A 21-year veteran of coaching at the Division I level, Betty Ann Kempf Townsley was introduced as the eighth head coach of women's soccer at West Chester University on July 29, 2007 and quickly led her team to the head of the class in NCAA Division II Women's soccer, amassing a 18-3-2 record, a PSAC conference championship, and a trip to the NCAA Regional Championship Game.

Kempf Townsley, who resigned from Seton Hall after 13 years at the helm, own 143 wins at the top level of intercollegiate athletics to go along with a coach of the year honor in the Big East Conference in 1997 and four trips to the conference tournament. Kempf Townsley guided the Seton Hall women's soccer team since its inception in 1994, before stepping down after the 2006 campaign. She built the Pirates into a reputable program, which has been competitive in the Big East-one of the top women's soccer conferences in the nation.

Kempf Townsley's 13 year record at Seton Hall is 103-118-17, with four winning seasons and four berths in the conference tournament, including two in the Big East Semifinals (1997 and 1999). In 22 seasons as a head coach, her marks stands at 161-205-24.

ABOUT the CAMP

The *WCU Girls Soccer Camp* is designed to provide insight to the tactical and technical aspects of the game. Players will be grouped by age and ability to work in small groups and learn skills of the game.

Participants will receive instruction on developing individual techniques in finishing, decision-making, footwork and attacking play.

The camp will be staffed by either collegiate or professional coaches and players.

The "*Little Kickers*" program is designed to teach children the game of soccer in a fun atmosphere.

ELIGIBILITY

Ages for the West Chester University Girls Soccer Camps range from 9-17. The Little Kickers Camp is for ages 4-9.

EQUIPMENT

WCU and its camp staff are not responsible for lost or missing items. **All personal equipment should be marked with the camper's name.** All campers are asked to bring comfortable sneakers and cleats, shinguards, container of water (no glass), sunscreen, extra t-shirt, socks and swimsuits. **Bring a practice ball!**

REFUND POLICY

Refunds will only be issued after the receipt of a written cancellation notice. Tuition cost includes a \$45 non-refundable processing fee. Additional refunds will not be granted after camp arrival. Full payment is due prior to the first day of camp. If the program is canceled, a full refund will be given.



RULES

Campers will be made aware of camp rules in a meeting on the first day of each session. Campers who violate these rules will be dismissed. Parents will be responsible for the cost of the damages to camp property by their child. **No refund** will be provided in case of dismissal.

FACILITIES

The camp programs will be conducted on the West Chester University soccer fields located across the street from John A. Farrell Football Stadium.

REGISTRATION

Due to limited enrollment, participants are urged to register as soon as possible. Applications will be accepted on a rolling basis. Camps are subject to change. You will be notified if you are affected.

Directions to WCU

From Philadelphia & Delaware County

Take Route 3 West to Route 202 South. Follow Route 202 South and exit at High Street. Follow High Street North to the second traffic light and make a left onto Rosedale Avenue. Follow Rosedale Avenue West to first traffic light and make a left onto New Street. Follow New Street South to Athletic Facilities on South Campus.

From Delaware & South

Take Route 202 North to Route 926 West. Turn left onto Route 926 West and go approximately one mile to New Street (first road). Make a right and follow New Street North to the Athletic Facilities on South Campus.

From Exton, Downingtown & Coatesville

Take Route 30 East to Route 100 South to Route 202 South. Follow Route 202 South and exit at High Street. Follow High Street North to the second traffic light and make a left onto Rosedale Avenue. Follow Rosedale Avenue West to first traffic light and make a left onto New Street. Follow New Street South to Athletic Facilities on South Campus.

From Southern Chester County

Take Route 1 to Route 52 North toward West Chester. Make a right onto Tigie Road, which is located just past Birmingham Road. Follow Tigie Road to New Street. Turn left onto New Street and follow North to the Athletic Facilities on South Campus.
