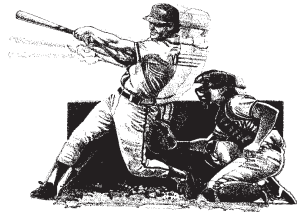

Greg Mamula is in his second season as head coach of the Golden Rams in 2008. In his first season, the Golden Rams finished with a 33-17 record and a second-place finish at the NCAA Division II Mid-Atlantic Regional, two wins short of advancing to the Division II World Series.

The success of Mamula's 2007 team came from a strong balance of offense, defense, and pitching. The 2007 Golden Rams led the PSAC in batting average (.328), scoring (7.6 runs per game), homeruns (34), doubles per game (2.18), and slugging percentage (.468). The 2007 team finished in the top 50 in all of NCAA Division II baseball in batting average (37th), doubles (27th), scoring (44th), and ERA (41st).

The 2007 team produced several individual honors, including PSAC Pitcher of the Year, Rookie of the Year, All-American, three all Mid-Atlantic Region Players and 10 first or second team all PSAC East players. The 2007 season also produced a 23rd round draft pick as the Toronto Blue Jays drafted senior left-hander Frank Gailey.

Prior to taking over at WCU, Mamula spent five seasons (2002-2006) as an assistant coach at the University of Delaware. In the summer of 2005, Mamula was the head coach of the Sanford Mariners of the New England Collegiate Baseball League, and in the summer of 1999, Mamula was the head coach of the Rome Indians of the New York Collegiate Baseball League. Mamula began his coaching career at Shippensburg University, spending three seasons as infielders coach and assisting with hitting and recruiting.

Mamula is a 1998 graduate of St. Bonaventure University, with a degree in elementary education. He was a four-year starter in the infield for the Bonnies, and was twice named to the A-10 all-academic team.

MEALS: *Rookie Campers do not eat meals.* The tuition cost for *Day Campers includes lunch Monday-Thursday in the WCU Cafeteria.*

MEDICAL CARE: The medical waiver on the back of the application must be completed and signed prior to any camper participation.

CHECK LIST OF THINGS TO BRING: Baseball cap, baseball shoes, sneakers, glove, bat and protective cup.

PLEASE DO NOT BRING - jewelry of any kind, glass water bottles (plastic only) or coolers.

REFUND POLICY: *Refunds will only be issued after the receipt of a written cancellation notice. Tuition cost includes a \$45 nonrefundable processing fee.* Any camper who leaves camp due to an injury or other medical reason will receive a prorated refund.

CONFIRMATION: All registered campers who provide a legible email address on their registration forms will receive an emailed confirmation indicating their spot in the camp. These emails will be sent out at least one week prior to the first day of camp.

REGISTRATION: Due to limited enrollment, participants are urged to register as soon as possible. Applications will be accepted on a rolling basis. Camps are subject to change. All registration will take place beginning 15 minutes before the first day of camp at Serpico Stadium.

Directions to WCU

From Philadelphia & Delaware County

Take Route 3 West to Route 202 South. Follow Route 202 South and exit at High Street. Follow High Street North to the second traffic light and make a left onto Rosedale Avenue. Follow Rosedale Avenue West to first traffic light and make a left onto New Street. Follow New Street South to South Campus Tennis Courts. **Make left into Tennis Courts and take road down hill to Serpico Baseball Stadium.**

From Delaware & South

Take Route 202 North to Route 926 West. Turn left onto Route 926 West and go approximately one mile to New Street (first road). Make right onto New Street and follow to South Campus Tennis Courts. **Make right at Tennis Courts and take road down hill to Serpico Baseball Stadium.**

From Exton, Downingtown & Coatesville

Take Route 30 East to Route 100 South to Route 202 South. Then follow directions **From Philadelphia & Delaware County.**

From Southern Chester County

Take Route 1 to Route 52 North toward West Chester. Make a right onto Tigre Road, which is located just past Birmingham Road. Follow Tigre Road to New Street. Turn left onto New Street and follow to South Campus Tennis Courts. **Make right at Tennis Courts and take road down hill to Serpico Baseball Stadium.**
