A 1982 graduate of West Chester University, Kathy Krannebitter was a starter on the 1978 National Championship field hockey team and the 1982 lacrosse team which finished seventh at the AIAW Nationals. She also was a member of the 1979 USWILCA National Champions. Prior to returning to West Chester in 1985, she served as assistant coach for field hockey and softball at the University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill for three years. In 1990, Krannebitter became the all-time leader in wins, surpassing WCU legend Vonnie Gros, and in 2006, she achieved her 200th career victory. Krannebitter's Golden Rams have twice captured the Atlantic 10 Regular Season Championship (1997 & 1998), and she has guided the Golden Rams to six A-10 playoff appearances. She has been active in the USFHA Development Camps since 1982, and she holds her USAFHA Certification.

Julie Lambi Field Coach
West Chester Univ

A 2005 graduate of Towson University, Julie Lambi owns the school's all-time scoring record (111 points) as well as the goals scored (44). She was a first team all league performer, and in her junior and senior years earned first team Regional All American Honors. Lambi begins her second season at West Chester, where she oversees and guides the attack. She has had previous coaching stints at the College of William and Mary, Dickinson College, and UMBC. Julie is still a very active player in both the indoor and outdoor games, and she has been coaching in the Futures Program for the past 3 years.

Carrie Hanshue Goalkeeping Coach
Appalachian State Univ

A four year starter while at West Chester, Carrie begins her second year as an Assistant Coach at Appalachian State University. An outstanding goalkeeper for West Chester, Carrie holds the Career Saves Record for the Rams. This feat rewarded her with a second team Regional All-American nod in her senior year. Carrie has coached in the Futures Program for 5 years in Pennsylvania, including serving as the Head Coach for the Harrisburg Area Futures Site for Goalkeepers

ABOUT the CAMP

The West Chester University Field Hockey Specialty Camps offer a unique opportunity for the serious field hockey athlete. The camps have been designed to challenge athletes in settings somewhat different from a traditional camp situation. The camps will offer tactics and techniques in scoring and goal keeping, as well as a tactical approach to the game through small game situations. We think these offerings will appeal to the serious field hockey athlete.

EQUIPMENT

WCU and its camp staff are not responsible for lost or missing items.

Please bring comfortably broken-in sneakers or turf shoes. Field Hockey sticks must be marked with name, and shinguards and mouthguards are mandatory. Sunscreen and a water jug (no glass) are recommended.

Absolutely NO cleats allowed!

Goalkeepers must bring their own equipment.

ELIGIBILITY

The WCU Field Hockey Goalkeeper/Shooters Camp as well as the Small Games Camp are for the serious field hockey athlete and are designed for players in GRADES 9-12.

FACILITIES

The camp programs will be conducted at WCU's new artificial turf field located behind the Sturzebecker Health Sciences Center (South Campus) on South New Street.

RULES

Campers will be made aware of camp rules in a meeting on the first day of each session. Campers who violate these rules will be dismissed. Parents will be responsible for the cost of the damages to camp property by their child. In case of dismissal, the camp fee will be prorated.

Directions to WCU

From Philadelphia & Delaware County

Take Route 3 West to Route 202 South. Follow Route 202 South and exit at High Street. Follow High Street North to the second traffic light and make a left onto Rosedale Avenue. Follow Rosedale Avenue West to first traffic light and make a left onto New Street. Follow New Street South to Athletic Facilities on South Campus.

From Delaware & South

Take Route 202 North to Route 926 West. Turn left onto Route 926 West and go approximately one mile to New Street (first road). Make a right and follow New Street North to the Athletic Facilities on South Campus.

From Exton, Downingtown & Coatesville

Take Route 30 East to Route 100 South to Route 202 South. Follow Route 202 South and exit at High Street. Follow High Street North to the second traffic light and make a left onto Rosedale Avenue. Follow Rosedale Avenue West to first traffic light and make a left onto New Street. Follow New Street South to Athletic Facilities on South Campus.

From Southern Chester County

Take Route 1 to Route 52 North toward West Chester. Make a right onto Tigie Road, which is located just past Birmingham Road. Follow Tigie Road to New Street. Turn left onto New Street and follow North to the Athletic Facilities on South Campus.
