Kassie Bellaver completed her second year at the reigns of the West Chester University volleyball team with a second consecutive trip to the PSAC Championships tournament and an overall record of 28-10.

Bellaver accepted her new position with WCU after serving as the head coach of NCAA Division III La Roche College in Pittsburgh since May of 2000.

An outstanding player for the Red Hawks who was the team's MVP in 1998, Bellaver took over the head coaching duties just a year after her graduation and had served in the part-time head coaching role until moving to West Chester in 2006.

She is a 1999 graduate (magna cum laude) of La Roche with a degree in psychology and received her master's degree in biology from Chatham College in August of 2003.

Bellaver's experience in coaching volleyball also extends to working with young athletes. She served as the head coach of the Beaver Valley Premier Junior Olympics program from November of 1998 until May of 2003, and has served as the camp director of the Economy Borough Summer Volleyball Camp since 1998.

She also coached the Renaissance Junior Olympic Volleyball Club from November of 2002 until May of 2003 and served as an assistant volleyball coach at Center High School during the 1999-2000 campaign.

Bellaver is a member of both the American Volleyball Coaches Association and the Pennsylvania Volleyball Coaches Association.

ABOUT the CAMPS

The **Day and Evening Volleyball Camps** offer instruction at the beginner and advanced levels. Beginners will focus on knowledge of the game, competitive fun, and fundamental ball control. Advanced campers will cover the proper technique for basic skills, offensive playsets, defensive formations, strategy, teamwork and attitude, and setting personal and team goals. Campers will be placed on teams, depending on skill level, with specialized coaching on each level.



FACILITIES

The camp program will be conducted at Hollinger Field House on North Campus.

EQUIPMENT

West Chester University and its camp staff are not responsible for lost or missing items. **All personal equipment should be marked with the camper's name.** Campers are required to bring comfortable volleyball or cross training sneakers, extra shirt and socks, and a container of water (no glass).

MEALS

Campers are responsible for bringing their own lunches with drinks and water each day.

RULES

Campers will be made aware of camp rules in a meeting on the first day of each session. Campers who violate these rules will be dismissed. Parents will be responsible for the cost of damages to camp property by their child. In case of dismissal, the camp fee will be prorated.

REFUND POLICY

Refunds will only be issued after the receipt of a written cancellation notice. Tuition cost includes a \$45 non-refundable processing fee. Any camper who leaves the camp due to an injury or for medical reasons will receive a prorated refund. Additional refunds will not be granted after camp arrival. Full payment is due prior to the first day of camp. If the program is canceled, a full refund will be given.

DIRECTIONS TO WCU

From Philadelphia & Delaware County

Take Route 3 West to Route 202 South. Follow Route 202 South and exit at High Street. Follow High Street North to the second traffic light and make a left onto Rosedale Avenue. Follow Rosedale Avenue West to first traffic light and make a right onto New Street. Follow New Street North to North Campus Drive and make a right. Follow to first stop sign and make a right into Hollinger parking lot.

From Delaware & South

Take Route 202 North to Route 926 West. Turn left onto Route 926 West and go approximately one mile to New Street (first road). Make a right and follow New Street North through the first traffic light and then to North Campus Drive. Make a right and then follow to first stop sign. Make a right into Hollinger parking lot.

From Exton, Downingtown & Coatesville

Take Route 30 East to Route 100 South to Route 202 South. Follow Route 202 South and exit at High Street. Follow High Street North to the second traffic light and make a left onto Rosedale Avenue. Follow Rosedale Avenue West to first traffic light and make a right onto New Street. Follow New Street North to North Campus Drive and make a right. Follow to first stop sign and make a right into Hollinger parking lot.

From Southern Chester County

Take Route 1 to Route 52 North toward West Chester. Make a right onto Niels Street. Follow Niels Street to the West Chester University campus. Cross over New Street into the campus on North Campus Drive. Follow to first stop sign and make a right into Hollinger parking lot.
