She has produced a 315-244 (155-83 PSAC East) record during her previous 20 years and has won more games than any other women's basketball coach in school history. Her overall mark is 357-272 in 23 years of collegiate coaching.

She was chosen the **2004 Carol Eckman Award National** winner and honored at the NCAA Division I Women's Final Four.

Kane has been directing successful basketball camps at West Chester for the past 20 years.

REFUND POLICY

Refunds will only be issued after the receipt of a written cancellation notice. **Tuition cost includes a \$45 non-refundable processing fee.** Any camper who leaves the camp due to injury or for medical reasons will receive a prorated refund. Additional refunds will not be granted after camp arrival. Full payment is due prior to the first day of camp. If the program is canceled, a full refund will be given.

EQUIPMENT

West Chester University and its camp staff are not responsible for lost or missing items. **All personal equipment should be marked with the camper's name.** All campers are asked to bring comfortable sneakers and a container of water each day (no glass please).

MEALS

Campers are responsible for bringing their own lunches each day.

ELIGIBILITY

Ages for the West Chester University Summer Girls Basketball programs range from 8-17. The Boys & Girls Kiddie Basketball Kamp ages range from 6-9. Due to NCAA Regulations, high school graduates are not permitted to attend.

RULES

Campers will be made aware of camp rules in a meeting on the first day of each session. Campers who violate these rules will be dismissed. Parents will be responsible for the cost of the damages to camp property by their child.

REGISTRATION SITE

Registration will take place at 9 a.m. the first day of camp. The Girls Basketball Camps and the Boys & Girls Kiddie Kamp will register and take place at the Sturzebecker Health Sciences Center on WCU's South Campus.

Directions to WCU

From Philadelphia & Delaware County

Take Route 3 West to Route 202 South. Follow Route 202 South and exit at High Street. Follow High Street North to the second traffic light and make a left onto Rosedale Avenue. Follow Rosedale Avenue West to first traffic light. (See directions below to Hollinger & Sturzebecker.)

From Delaware & South

Take Route 202 North into West Chester where it becomes High Street. Follow High Street north to the second traffic light and make a left onto Rosedale Avenue. Follow Rosedale Avenue west to first traffic light. (See directions below to Hollinger & Sturzebecker.)

From Exton, Downingtown & Coatesville

Take Route 30 East to Route 100 South to Route 202 South. Follow Route 202 South and exit at High Street. Follow Rosedale Avenue west to first traffic light. (See directions below to Hollinger & Sturzebecker.)

To Hollinger Field House

Make a right onto New Street. Follow New Street north 3/4 of the way through the block to North Campus Drive. Make a right onto North Campus Drive and proceed to first stop sign. Make a right into the parking lot. Hollinger is located in the southeast corner.

To Sturzebecker Health Sciences Center

Make a left onto New Street. Follow New Street south for about a mile. Building will be on the left just before the football stadium.

From Southern Chester County

Take Route 1 to Route 52 North to West Chester. Make right onto Rosedale Avenue. Follow Rosedale east to first traffic light (New Street). Make a right to take New Street South to the Sturzebecker Health Sciences Center. Make a left to take New Street North to Hollinger Field House. (Then see directions above to Hollinger & Sturzebecker.)
