Hammond, former Director of Golf at Whitford Country Club in Exton, PA, and now Director of Golf at Penn Oaks Golf Club in West Chester, PA, brings a great deal of coaching experience with him to the collegiate level. More than 25 of his former pupils have gone on to sign scholarships with Division I golf programs.

Hammond inherited a squad that captured its first Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference (PSAC) title in 38 years last October and advanced two individuals to the NCAA Tournament.

Mike Thompson begins his fourth year as the head women's golf coach at West Chester University. A PGA professional since 1970, Thompson has spent close to 40 years in the golf profession as a player, teacher, and coach. He is presently a teaching professional with The Golf Zone in Honey Brook, PA.

Thompson has also spent time as a teaching pro throughout the Delaware Valley at Whitford Country Club, the West Chester Golf & Country Club, the Brandywine Country Club, and the Springhaven Club. He also served as producer of the television show "Practical Golf with Mike Thompson."

Thompson has an outstanding background in player development and junior golf. In 2001 he won the Junior Golf Leader award presented by the Philadelphia Section of the PGA. The veteran golf professional has coordinated and instructed golf camps for the city of Philadelphia, and currently serves as the co-chair of the Philadelphia Section of the Junior Golf Committee, a position he has held since 1998.

Take Route 3 West to Route 202 South. Follow Route 202 South to Penn Oaks Drive on your left (approximately one mile after crossing Route 926).

### *From Delaware & South*

Take Route 202 North to Penn Oaks Drive on your right (approximately five miles after crossing Route 1).

### *From Exton, Downingtown & Coatesville*

Take Route 30 East to Route 100 South to Route 202 South. Follow Route 202 South to Penn Oaks Drive (approximately one mile after crossing Route 926).

### *From Southern Chester County*

Take Route 1 North to Route 202 North. Follow Route 202 North to Penn Oaks Drive (approximately five miles after turning on to Route 202).
